

How to - Configure Barracuda Email Security Gateway to forward logs to EventTracker

EventTracker v9.0 and Above

Abstract

This guide provides instructions to configure **Barracuda Email Security Gateway** to send the log to EventTracker. Once log source is being configured to send to EventTracker, alerts, and reports can be configured into EventTracker.

Scope

The configurations detailed in this guide are consistent with **EventTracker** version 9.x and later, **Barracuda Email Security Gateway VX600**.

Audience

Administrators who are responsible for monitoring Barracuda Email security Gateway which are running using EventTracker.

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1. Overview

The **Barracuda Email Security Gateway** is an integrated hardware and software solution designed to protect your email server from spam, virus, spoofing, phishing and spyware attacks. Outbound filtering and encryption options also prevent Data Leakage Prevention (DLP). The optional cloud protection layer (CPL) shields email servers from inbound malware and DoS attacks while filtering out normal spam before it ever touches the network's perimeter.

2. Prerequisites

- **EventTracker v9.x** should be installed.
- **Barracuda Email security gateway VX600** or above should be installed and configured.
- An exception should be added into windows firewall on EventTracker machine for syslog port **514**.

3. Configuring Barracuda Email Security Gateway to EventTracker

1. Log in to the Barracuda Web Filter web interface.
2. Select **Advanced > Advanced Networking**.
3. In the **Syslog Configuration** section, specify the IP address of the **EventTracker** in the Mail Syslog and Web Interface Syslog fields.
4. Enter port **514** and select **UDP** protocol.

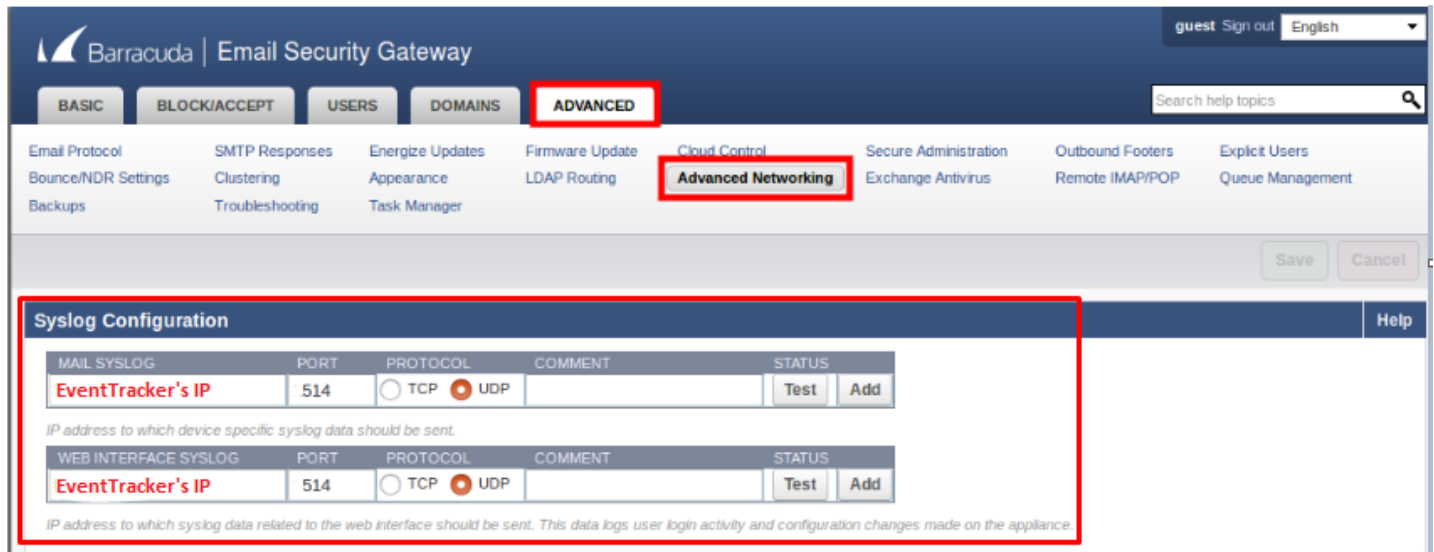

5. Click **Add** and save. The syslog configuration is complete.
